This week I would like to expand on our financial standpoint a little more as we enter into our winter season. As many of you know, during the winter months there are many more expenses that are incurred due to heating bills and parking lot maintenance to keep things safe. Of our fifteen buildings seven of them get used on a daily basis which means that there is extensive heating costs that go with these buildings. Due to the age of the buildings and the size, heating has always been rather difficult.

Last year we had an expense of \$21,689.20 for heating all of our buildings which includes both electric and heating. We have applied for a grant this year to help offset some of the costs for the food pantry located at Kiefer hall but will still need your help as much as possible to help keep our campuses warm and welcoming.

Here is a rough breakdown of the yearly utility costs for each campus. The totals listed below include Municipal Commission Electric (SJ), National Grid - Electric (SP), National Grid - Natural Gas (SJ) Propane & Fuel (SP) and Water and Sewer Bills for both locations.

St Josephs **\$ 9,596.43**

- Church (Natural Gas)
- Rectory (Electric Heat)
- Gill Hall (Natural Gas)
- Parish office (Natural Gas)

St Patrick's \$ 11,633.40

- Church (Fuel Oil)
- Kiefer Hall (Propane)
- Thrift Store (Propane)

St Mary of the Snows \$ 459.37

- Church (Fuel Oil – Last delivery in 2019)

St. Joseph's & St. Patrick's campuses have had recent work done on the heating systems so that they are energy efficient. Due to the size and the age of many of these buildings it makes heating them rather expensive. We currently have roughly six extra collections a year for heating and fuel but will still need to pay careful attention to our income so that we can pay the heating bills, payroll, and monthly office expenses. I would ask that you stay tuned and continue to support your parish as much as you are able during the winter months as they are our most difficult months financially.




