Dear Parishioners.

This weekend, as I previously mentioned in last weekend's announcements, the roof at St Patrick's is coming along great. If you have not had a chance to take a look at it, it looks great. I would like to take an opportunity to thank Craig Trainor from Prestige Construction and his crew who have been working diligently to replace the old roof which was in much need of repair. We also replaced the roof at the Thrift Store which was in disrepair. We had a number of active leaks around the chimney and a few other places which suffered some water damage over the years. There was significant damage to a lot of the plywood on that roof which was replaced to insure that there will be no further water damage. As you all know, most of our buildings are more than 100 years old which means that there are significant maintenance issues that will begin to arise over the next few years.

So far, over the last year we have made some updates to St Patrick's cemetery by putting a maintenance shed on the property which makes things much more efficient than having to trailer things over there each time we have a burial. We have made a few updates to the rectory roof and upstairs bathroom. We have also updated the Bell System at St Joseph's, thanks to your support between the overage of the Hope Appeal, and other donations towards the bell system. These are just some of the things that we can do when we, as a Parish come together to make some much needed updates to our buildings.

One of the other projects which a number of people have brought to my attention is the Parish Hall at St Joseph's. Gill Hall used to be a house which was converted and expanded to a Parish hall. Over the years, significant updates have been made to the heating system at that building. Though we have updated the heating system in that building to a natural gas furnace, the loss of heat through the windows is a challenge due to their age. New windows would greatly increase the efficiency of the heating system in that building and allow for less fuel consumption and lower heating costs. I am currently in the process of getting quotes for updating windows and seeing what we can do to update the kitchen so that we can begin to have events and functions in there again.

As always, I like to keep people informed of where we stand with projects and updates to our campus. As many of you know, I like to be up front about anything that is needed, not only to make our buildings more efficient, but I also would like to have a place where we can gather as a Parish for catechesis, community building, and Parish events. We as a Parish, can do things together that would be most difficult on our own. Let's take this opportunity to continue to come together and make the Parish of Christ our Hope the best that it can be.


