Rosary Making will resume on Mondays following the morning mass at Gill Hall. We will continue this activity until Fall. Any questions, please contact the Parish office.

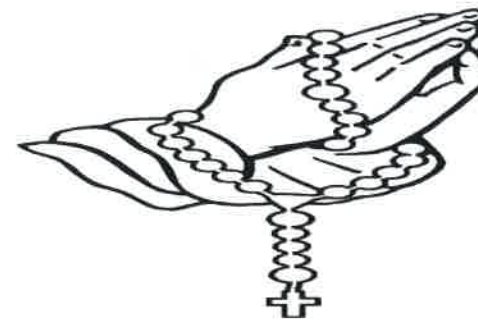

This weekend we are challenged in a few different ways in our readings. As we read through the readings this week at Mass, I would encourage you to re-read them throughout the week and ask yourself how do they still apply to you? I want you to think for a moment, what are some of the cares and struggles you have in your life at this moment? I am sure we have all had an experience in doing a task that we get so caught up in, that we forget other things that we are supposed to be doing.

I remember countless times in the seminary that I was so worried about getting an assignment done that something was bound to slip my mind. It's easy to do in our daily lives when we are so caught up in trying to balance so many things. We have all had parties or had company in our homes. What happens? We want to make sure that our home is in order, and things look as best as they can. We make sure that the rooms are clean, food is bought, and prepared. Everything is complete to the best of our abilities. As always, something is bound to get in the way or we forget something.

We meet two characters in our Gospel this weekend, Martha and Mary. Likewise, our Gospel reading has two messages today that we can take away. We can allow Jesus into our lives in two different ways. First, we can constantly prepare our hearts for Him, and try to be ready. On the other hand, we can allow Jesus to come into the messiness of our lives and just be with Him. For each of us, there will be different situations that allow both of these to happen. It's normal to want to make things perfect for those around us, as well as the Lord. In another light, it's also normal for us to realize that we cannot control every outcome in our lives. Take some time this week and ask yourself, who do you identify with more, Martha or Mary? In our lives, we need a healthy balance of both outcomes; preparation and relaxation.
