Dear Parishioners,

As many of you know, St. Mary's of the
Snows operates a seasonal Chapel in Otter
Lake from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Each
year the Bishop gives permission to open the
Church for the spiritual needs of the
community. A number of people have asked
me about keeping St. Mary's opened past
Labor Day until Columbus Day. Permission
was granted from Bishop Lucia only until
Labor Day, but there is more to my decision to
only operate the Church from Memorial Day to
Labor Day. Since the Church was made a
seasonal Chapel in the early 2000s, it has
operated from Memorial Day to Labor Day. It
operates this way much because, many
people who attend St. Mary's are spending
time at camp or traveling farther North for
vacation. Also, this year we are moving to a
different program for Faith Formation which
will be a weekly program. One of my roles as
the priest is to be present for the program and
to be able to interact with the students and
to help where needed. The final weekend for the
11:15AM Mass will be Labor Day weekend
and then we will reopen Memorial Day
weekend 2023.

We have shifted our program for Family
Formation from two times a month from what
we did last year, to a weekly program this year.
This program will focus on the Gospel for the
week and implement the Gospel into the class
each week. This will allow for a closer
relationship between the Mass and Faith
Formation. One of the things that a lot of
people have asked for is to have the kids
involved at Mass on Sundays. By doing this, it
shows the future of the Church and gives the
kids a chance to participate in reading at
Mass, bringing the gifts up, altar serving, and
being a part of the Mass in such a way that
they don't normally get a chance to do.

If you have any questions, please feel free
to reach out to me by calling the office, setting
up a time to meet with me, or emailing me. I
am looking forward to this new year and new
program. I think it will be an exciting year and
a new endeavor for our young people.
