Dear Parishioners,

Just as a reminder, Labor Day weekend will be our Final Mass of the year at St Mary of the Snows in Otter Lake. It has been a great year and I thank everyone for their support.

A wise man once said that humility isn't thinking less of yourself; it's thinking of yourself less. That's what both Sirach and Jesus tell us in today's readings. Humility helps us take the spotlight off ourselves. And when we stop putting ourselves first, we become more open to the people around us. This is very similar to what the Blessed Mother did throughout her life. Everything she did pointed directly back to Jesus or God instead of pointing to her.

Humility helps us in two ways: we see people differently, and they see us differently. Humility allows us to better see the needs, desires, and struggles of the people around us. Jesus said something similar in his parable about taking the lowest place at a banquet. As we take our attention off what we think we deserve or what we think will make us look good, we stop trying to claim recognition for ourselves. At times, we can be tempted to think that a humble person is someone who lets other people walk all over them. And who wants to be like that? The truth is, true humility requires great strength. It takes a lot for us to admit when we are wrong or when we have faults. No one likes to admit when they are wrong but it is a part of growing and allowing ourselves to see ourselves as we truly are. Take an opportunity this week to ask God for the graces to be able to be humble and to truly understand the gift of humility.

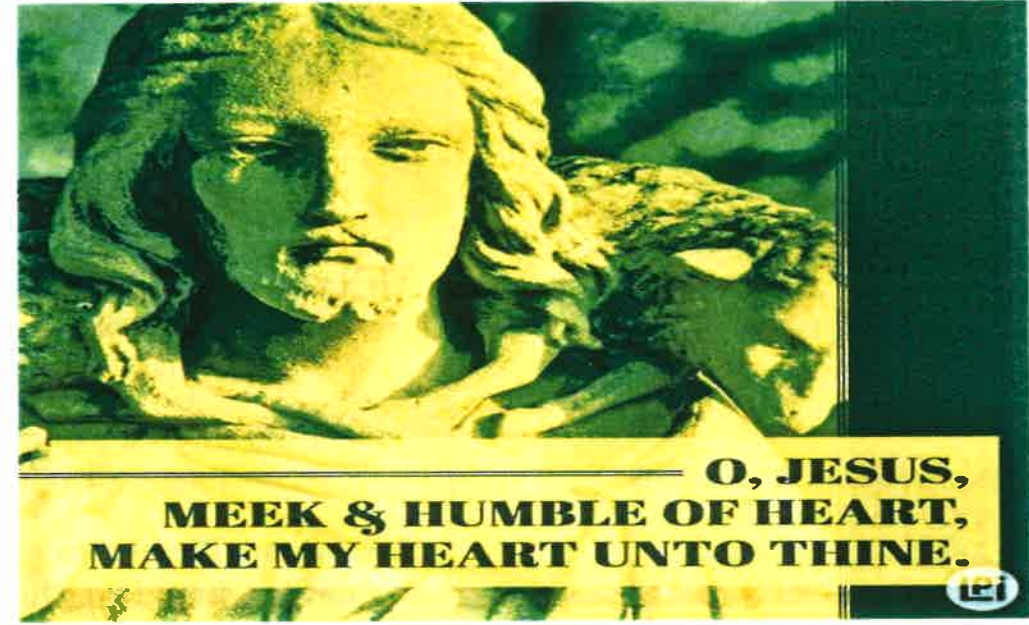
