Dear Parishioners,

When I was a kid, my father would always listen to country music while driving. Often, I didn't pay attention to it but, there was one song by Garth Brooks that I remember hearing when I was a kid that says: "Sometimes I thank God, for unanswered prayers, remember when you're talking to the man upstairs, that just because he doesn't answer, doesn't mean He don't care, some of God's greatest gifts are unanswered prayers." This song embodies and is the result of our readings this week. When we pray, we should pray always. But our prayer, as we know, is not always answered in the way that we desire. In the song "Unanswered Prayers" by Garth Brooks, he and his wife run into his old high school girlfriend. As he reminisced about the old days and how things used to be he realized and thanked God for not answering his prayer in the way that he originally wanted. He realized now that God answered his prayer in the way that was needed versus the way in which Garth wanted. He realized now that he was much happier than he would have been with what he prayed for.

So often I hear people get discouraged when they pray and say that God doesn't answer their prayer. I am always quick to gently remind them that prayers are answered in God's time and in God's way. Sometimes, they are not answered in the way we think. And others, they turn out to be more of a challenge, but we learn so much from them.

In the Gospel, we are reminded to keep Praying! Many of the saints and scripture writers say "pray without ceasing" in a world torn by division, we are called to pray. Not only for ourselves, friends, and family, but also our enemies and those we disagree with. Even Jesus prayed for those who beat Him and hung Him on the Cross. We are called to have that same conviction to pray whether it is for our friends or those we disagree with.

At the heart of our prayer, we must remember that just when you feel as though God may not answer, some of God's greatest gifts are the things we may consider unanswered. God answers all of our prayers, just in His own way and in His own time.
