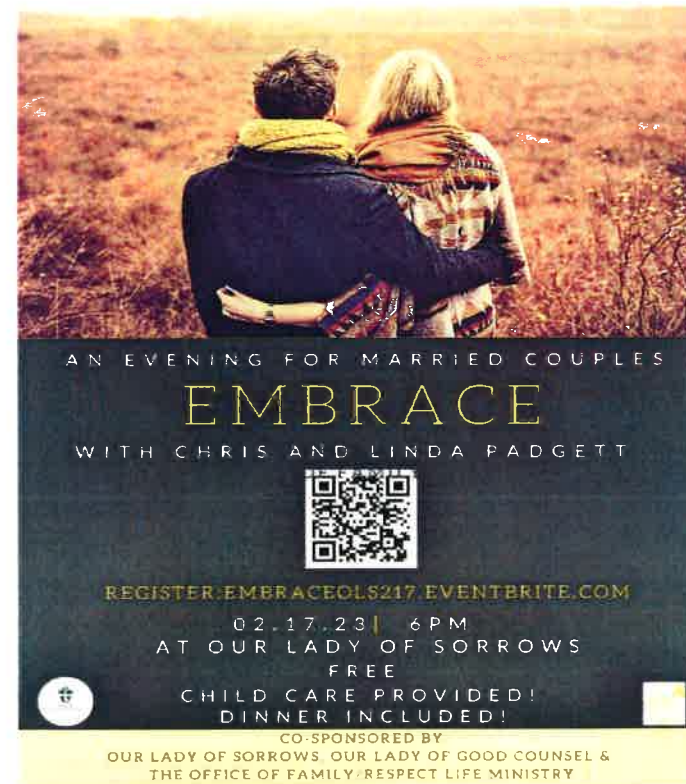

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is Word of God Sunday. This week we are called to listen with a profound ear to what the word of God is saying. This really isn't different to other weeks, as we should be drawn into what God is saying to us in the Liturgy of the Word each week. This week is set aside in the Church calendar each year to allow us to renew our own commitment to listen to the Word of God and act on it. Every day of our lives we are called to make decisions and we should be able to make God a part of those decisions. What does it mean to make Him a part of those decisions? Do we invite Him into making those difficult decisions or do we make them on our own? Do we allow ourselves to make the decisions on our own when we find those small victories, or do we thank God for helping us get to that destination?

In the Gospel this week, we hear the calling of the 12 Apostles. We know that many of the disciples were ordinary fisherman with little to no background in theology or ministry. This is one of the most beautiful parts of our faith. Simply put, is that Christ calls each of us to follow Him no matter what our background or our past. For some of us, we may see ourselves as not worthy to follow Him, while others are simply thankful to be called. Each of us are called by our baptism and called to holiness and greatness. Each day, the Lord taught His disciples, both publicly as well as in private. One can only imagine what that teaching must have been like. Not only to be witnesses to the miracles that Jesus had done, but also to having Him explain His teaching in private. This should remind us that the Lord will call us no matter what our qualifications are or what we have done in the past. There is an old saying that I can remember that describes this passage perfectly, "God does not call the qualified He qualifies the called." For each of us we are called to follow Him everyday of our lives, to listen to the Word of God and to respond with action as the disciples did. It may not always be as simple as it was for the disciples, but we can continue to strive for that "Yes" everyday of our lives. How will you respond to the Word of God this week?
