Dear Parishioners,

This week, we will need volunteers for the washing  
of feet for Holy Thursday. This is open to anyone.  
Anyone who would like to have their feet washed  
please sign up in the back of the Church. We will also  
need lectors and Eucharistic Ministers for Holy  
Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter  
Sunday. As a reminder, Please check the Sign up sheet  
in the back of the Church to sign up for any positions  
that still need to be filled. Monday of this week, I will  
be in the Confessional from 3-7PM. Anyone who would  
like to go to confession is welcome, whether it has been  
a week or many years, this is a beautiful time to return  
to the Lord and come to Confession.

As we begin this Holy Week, we remember Christ’s  
entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. Tones of  
happiness and triumph fill our readings, but quickly  
fade into shouts of “Crucify Him”. When we begin the  
Liturgy, Palms are blessed and we start with the phrase  
“Hosanna to the Son of David, Blessed is He who  
comes in the Name of the Lord.” While in the Gospel,  
we hear the shouting of the crowd for Christ’s death.

As we go through this week, I encourage you to  
slow down and join us for each Liturgy. Palm Sunday,  
we will distribute and bless the palms which signify His  
triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Holy Thursday, we  
turn to the most solemn part of the week as we begin  
the Sacred Triduum. This day, we will celebrate the  
Last Supper of Jesus and hear how Jesus washes the  
Disciples feet, an act of humility which will be both  
challenged and embraced. Friday, we will recall the  
death of Jesus and have an opportunity to venerate the  
cross and a time of prayer. Friday evening, we will pray  
the Stations off the Cross together and have another  
opportunity for prayer. Saturday, we will recall the time  
of waiting in darkness at the Easter Vigil. During this  
time, we celebrate the Light of Christ as it is renewed  
and given to each person. This year, we will also  
welcome three new facsimiles into our church and 5  
people will be receiving the Sacraments for the first  
time. This is a beautiful opportunity to not only receive  
the Sacraments, but also be welcomed into the Church.  
Finally, on Easter Sunday we recall His Resurrection  
and triumph over Sin and Death.

May this Holy Week allow you to journey with  
Christ as we recall His Passion, Death, and  
Resurrection, May your hearts be filled with His Grace  
and Mercy as we prepare to celebrate the Resurrection.
