Dear Parishioners,

You will see an insert in this weekend's bulletin, regarding this past year's Hope Appeal. This is an impact sheet that give us a detailed overview of where all the donations have gone from our donations this past year. I would encourage you to look at this as it gives a great overview to the various ministries throughout the Diocese that are impacted by our donations.

Our Gospel this weekend is taken from Matthew 11:25-30. It offers comfort, hope, and a reminder of God's love and grace. In these six verses, Jesus speaks to his disciples and expresses gratitude to God for revealing his truths to the humble and the childlike.

The passage begins with Jesus thanking God for hiding the knowledge of the kingdom from the wise and learned, and revealing it to the little children. This statement challenges the conventional wisdom of the time, which valued intellectual prowess and worldly knowledge. Jesus emphasizes that true understanding of God's kingdom comes from a heart that is humble and open, like that of a child. This reminds me of the importance of approaching God with a childlike faith, without preconceived notions or a desire to rely solely on human wisdom.

Jesus then extends an invitation to all who are weary and burdened to come to him and find rest. This invitation is deeply comforting, as it reassures me that in the midst of life's challenges and struggles, I can find solace in Jesus. It reminds me that I do not have to carry my burdens alone, but that I can rely on him for strength and support.

Jesus goes on to describe his yoke as easy and his burden as light. This imagery is powerful, as it contrasts with the burdens we often carry in life. Jesus offers a different way of living, one that is characterized by his grace and love. This passage reminds me to surrender my own desires and ambitions to God, and to take on his yoke instead. It is a call to follow Jesus, to learn from him, and to find rest in his presence.

This passage is a beautiful reminder of God's love and grace. It invites us to approach God with childlike faith, to find rest in Jesus, and to let go of our burdens and take on his yoke. It offers comfort and hope in the midst of life's challenges and reminds us that we are not alone. As I reflect on this passage, I am encouraged to trust in God's goodness and to rely on his strength in all areas of my life.
