Dear Parishioners,

A few questions have been raised as to why we are charging for dinner at our Fall Festival and why it is not free. While I believe that it is a good opportunity for us to come together as a parish family of Christ Our Hope, there is still a significant cost for something like this to occur. It has been several years since we have had a parish event like this, and I wanted to allow everyone to come and gather and not have to worry about bringing a dish to pass or worrying about what to bring.

As I mentioned last weekend, we will be offering chicken dinners for \$12 dollars which will include a 1/2 chicken, salt potatoes, baked beans, and a dinner roll. We will also be providing hamburgers and hotdogs at no charge so if you do not want a chicken dinner, hamburgers and hotdogs will be available. As mentioned there will be a Chinese auction as well as a 50/50 raffle. There will also be music and games for the kids. I look forward to seeing everyone there! Even if you can't come for the whole time feel free to stop by. Dinner will be available starting at 3pm and be available until about 4:30pm. This event is not necessarily a fundraiser but some of the money for the chicken dinners will help defray the cost for that and the auction and raffle will help our parish out a little financially before we begin winter.

We will be offering more events such as a winter gathering, and possibly monthly lunch gatherings. I am looking forward to our Fall Festival as the first event and hoping that will open the door to many other events in the parish. I have to remind myself at times that it's one step at a time. I realize that we want to have many events but let's make this one a special event so that we can continue other events throughout the year!

As we begin our faith formation this year, I am excited for another fun filled year. We have a number of family events planned throughout the year such as a fall hike up Bald Mountain in Old Forge, sledding in the winter, and bowling in the spring. There will also be a Christmas party as well. Please check the calendar and keep an eye on the bulletin. For many of these events they will occur in the afternoon after faith formation, I realize sports have become an issue on Sunday mornings at times, but please make every effort to come to class each week as well as to our family events.
