Dear Parishioners,

First of all, I want to thank everyone for what they
have given over the last year financially. I realize that
it has not been an easy year. This weekend, I want to
call your attention to the insert in the bulletin. This
gives a simple breakdown as to where we are
financially. Throughout the last year, we have been
doing a number of major projects that have cost a
significant amount of money. Overall, we are doing
"OK" financially but as you will see we are still in a
deficit. I will explain this in more detail over the
weekend. This weekend and over the next few
weekends, I will be putting some information out
about what happens to your money that gets donated
over the weekend and where it goes. Simply put,
your donation on Sunday goes to help the Parish as a
whole to function. When we collect the money over
the weekend, it is kept safe until Monday when a pair
of volunteers appointed by me, count it, and then it
gets taken to the bank and deposited into our
checking account. Any money that is given for fuel
and heat, repairs and improvements, also stay in our
Parish and are restricted for those purposes. When
we have a second collection such as respect life,
Peter's Pence, or Missionary Sunday, those are called
Diocesan Collections that go to help fund those
specific ministries either in our Diocese or outside of
it. When we have those collections, they are also
counted by us, and deposited into our Parish
checking account. We then write a check to the
Diocese of Syracuse who facilitates the money
getting to its proper Ministry. The "ordinary"
collection, which is your weekly envelope, or if you
put loose money in the first collection, it remains
here at Christ our Hope Parish to help our ministry,
and everyday expenses.

I want to remind everyone again that we are a Parish
Family of Christ our Hope. Our mission Statement
says that we are the "Catholic Community of
Northern Oneida County". While we are comprised
of three different worship sites in Boonville,
Forestport, and Otter Lake, we are one formal
corporation. We do not operate as individual
parishes. The money that is donated on a weekly
basis is put into the "Christ our Hope" checking
account and then is used for the functioning of all
three of our campuses which includes a total of 12
physical buildings. Stay tuned next week for a
breakdown of our expenses and what it takes to run a
parish.
