Dear Parishioners,

I want to give everyone an update on where we stand on our Hope Appeal. Currently between gifts and pledges, we have raised \$12,804 dollars of our 18,175.00 dollar goal. I will remind everyone that whatever amount we go over, we will receive 100 percent of that back to the parish. This is a great opportunity to be able to help those in need as we hear in our Gospel this weekend.

This weekend we celebrate the solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe. We are reminded of the profound truth that Jesus Christ is the ultimate ruler of the universe, both in heaven and on earth. This feast is always celebrated on the last Sunday of ordinary time and marks the end of our liturgical year. This weekend our readings invite us to contemplate the sovereignty and majesty of Christ. At the heart of Christ's kingship is his selfless love and sacrifice. Unlike earthly kings who seek power and control, Jesus reigns through humility and service. He demonstrated this through his birth in a lowly stable, his ministry of healing and mercy, and ultimately, his death on the cross for the redemption of humanity. In his resurrection, he conquered sin and death, establishing his eternal kingdom.

Christ's kingship challenges us to examine our own lives. Are we willing to submit to his authority and follow his example of love and service? As his subjects, we are called to imitate his compassion, forgiveness, and generosity. We are reminded that true greatness lies in selflessness, not in the pursuit of worldly power or possessions. In a world that often values material success, Christ the King reminds us of what truly matters. His kingship invites us to reevaluate our priorities and align them with his teachings. It calls us to seek justice, promote peace, and care for the marginalized and vulnerable. Christ's reign extends to every aspect of our lives, and we are called to live as his ambassadors, bringing his love and mercy to all we encounter.

The solemnity of Christ the King also points us towards the future. It reminds us that this earthly life is not the end, but a preparation for the eternal kingdom that awaits us. We are called to live with hope and anticipation, knowing that one day, we will share in the glory of Christ's reign forever. This weekend, Jesus challenges us to recognize and embrace Him as the true ruler of our lives. It calls us to live in accordance with his teachings, seeking to love and serve others as he did. This feast invites us to reorient our priorities and find true fulfillment in surrendering to his authority. Let us embrace the kingship of Christ, allowing his love and grace to transform us and the world around us.
