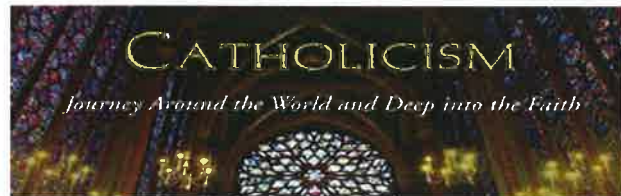

Dear Parishioners,



This week we celebrate Palm Sunday. This Sunday holds great significance in the our faith. It marks the beginning of Holy Week, a time of deep reflection and preparation for the celebration of Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday. This day is a powerful reminder of the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion and the ultimate sacrifice he made for humanity. Palm Sunday derives its name from the palm branches that were laid on the ground as a symbol of honor and adoration when Jesus entered Jerusalem. The crowds welcomed him with shouts of joy, proclaiming him as the long-awaited Messiah. This triumphant entry fulfilled the prophecies of the Old Testament, specifically Zechariah 9:9, which describes the coming of a humble king riding on a donkey.

As we participate in the liturgy and receive the blessed palms, we are invited to open our hearts and allow Jesus to enter and reign in every aspect of our lives. Palm Sunday holds deep spiritual significance. It is a time of reflection, humility, and preparation for the celebration of Christ's resurrection. It calls us to welcome Jesus into our hearts and to live as his faithful disciples, ready to follow him on the journey of salvation.

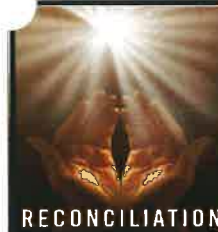

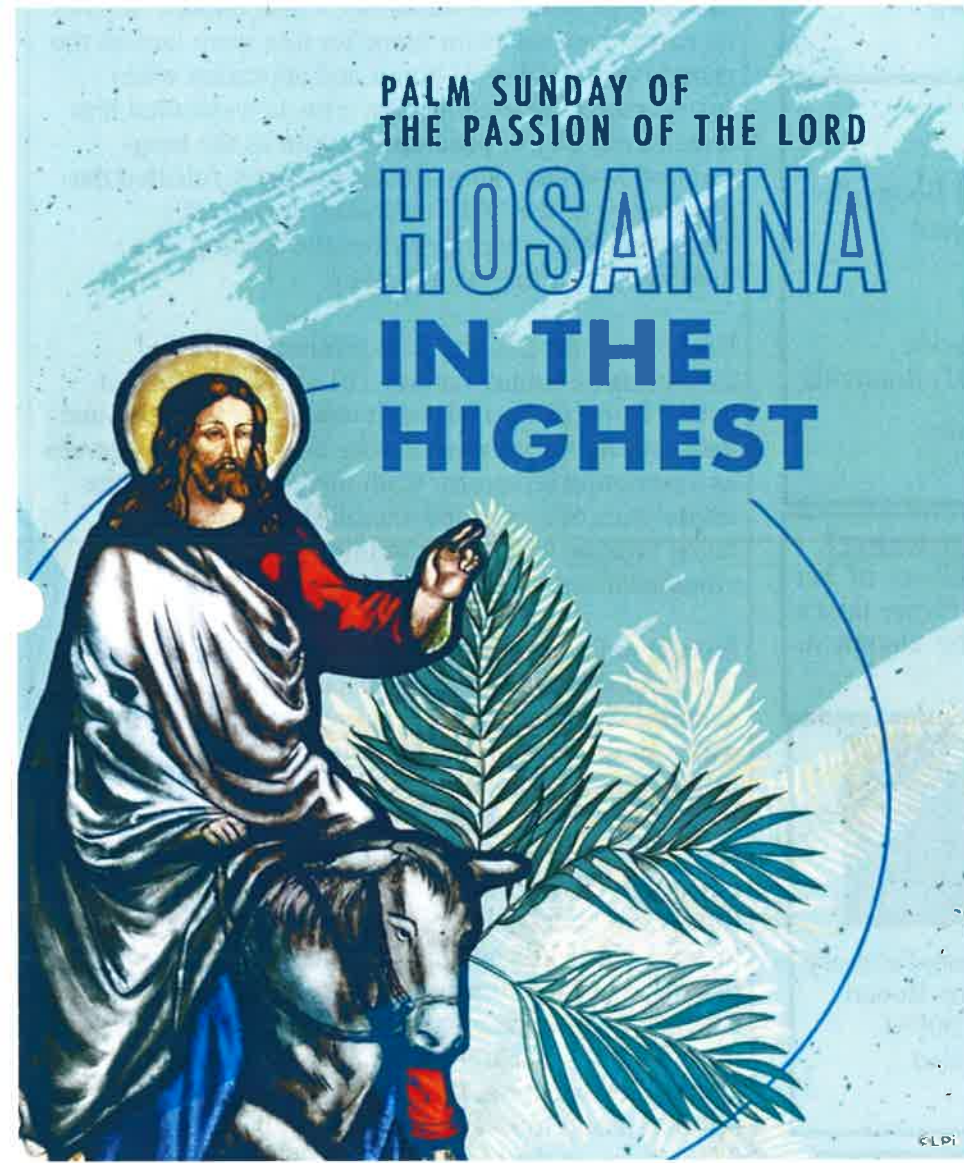
