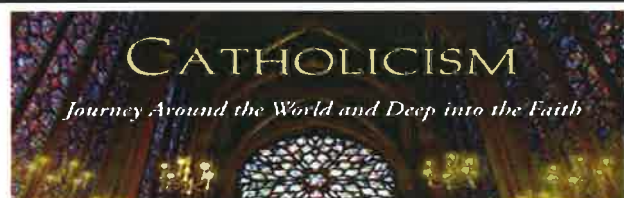

This Sunday we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Each year we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday on the Sunday after Easter. This was first established by Pope John Paul II in 2000, based on the visions and messages received by a Polish nun named Saint Faustina Kowalska. On this day, we are reminded of the depth of God's mercy and the invitation to receive His forgiveness and grace. It is a time to reflect on the sacrifice of Jesus Christ and His resurrection, which brings us the gift of salvation. Divine Mercy Sunday is an opportunity to deepen our understanding of God's mercy and to seek reconciliation with Him and others.

Divine Mercy Sunday serves as a reminder that no matter how broken or sinful one may feel, God's mercy is always ready to be given. It is a time to reflect on our weaknesses and shortcomings and to seek forgiveness and healing. The image of the Divine Mercy, with the rays of red and white symbolizing the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side on the cross, reminds us of the immense love and mercy that God has for each and every one of us.

Divine Mercy Sunday also prompts us to extend mercy and forgiveness to others. It challenges us to let go of grudges, reconcile with those who may have hurt us, and show compassion to those in need. It is a call to live out the message of Mercy in our daily life, to be a vessel of God's love and mercy to others. This is a time of deep reflection and gratitude for the mercy of God. It is a reminder of the incredible love that God has for us and the invitation to receive His forgiveness and grace. May we always be open to His mercy and strive to extend that mercy to others.






