This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. This is often one of the most difficult feasts to preach on as well as to explain. I believe there is one word that can describe this feast day, and that is "love". Within the Trinity, we have three persons, in one God: God the Father, who creates, God the Son, who redeems the world by His death and Resurrection, and God the Holy Spirit, who sanctifies and makes holy. Each time we begin Mass we remind ourselves of the Holy Trinity by making the sign of the Cross. As we sign ourselves, we make mention of Father, Son, and Spirit, and recall the death and resurrection of Christ.

On the front of our bulletin this week, we have an icon known as the Rublev icon, named after Andrei Rublev, who lived in Russia in the 14th century. This beautiful depiction portrays the Trinity in such a way that they all appear similar and point to each other, which means that no one person is more important than the other. As we focus on the Trinity this week, let us remember that God wants to be with us and gives us three persons in one God in the Holy Trinity.





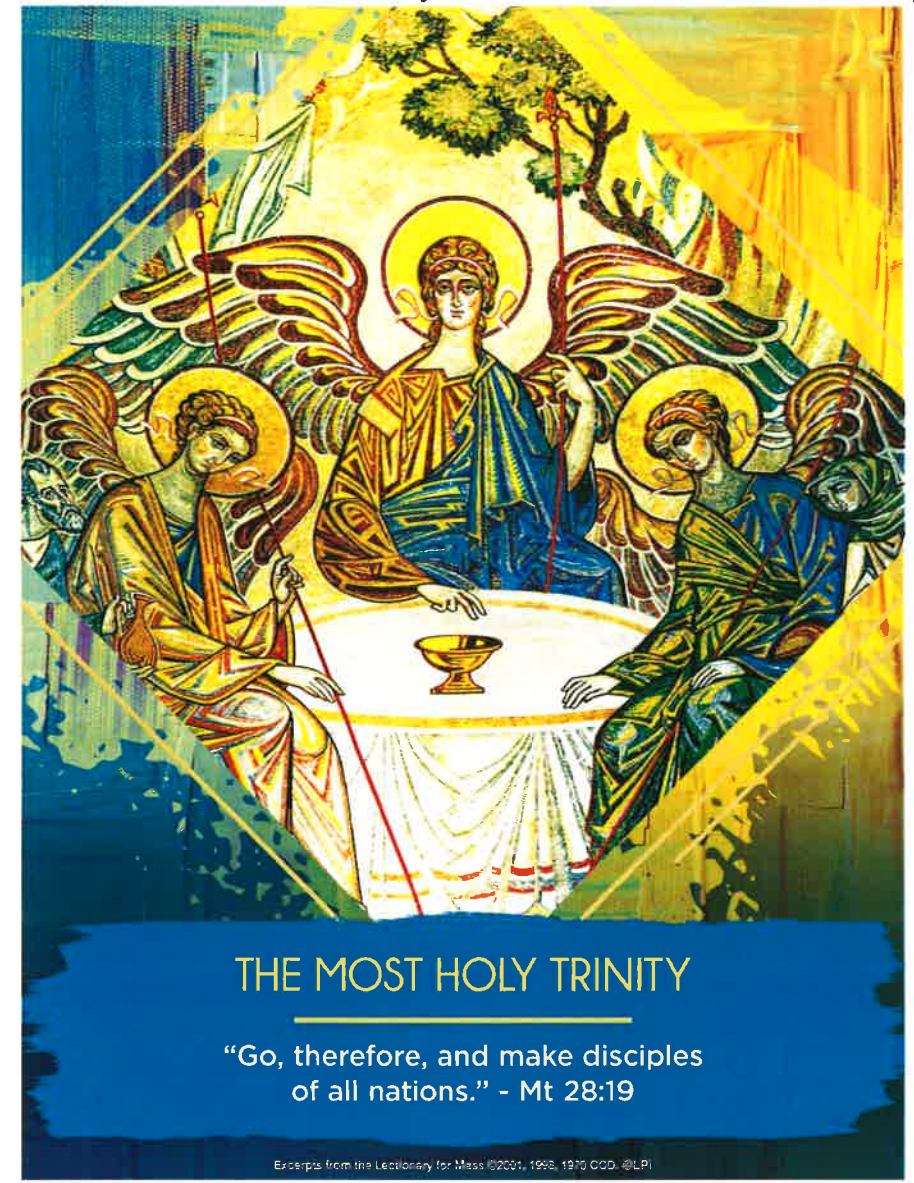
