

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is through



simple signs of bread and wine that the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity is made present to us.

We hear in the Gospel today that I am the living bread that comes down from heaven. Christ gave us the Eucharist as a remembrance of Him on the night before He was to die. On Holy Thursday we celebrate what is called the Institution of the Eucharist. 
