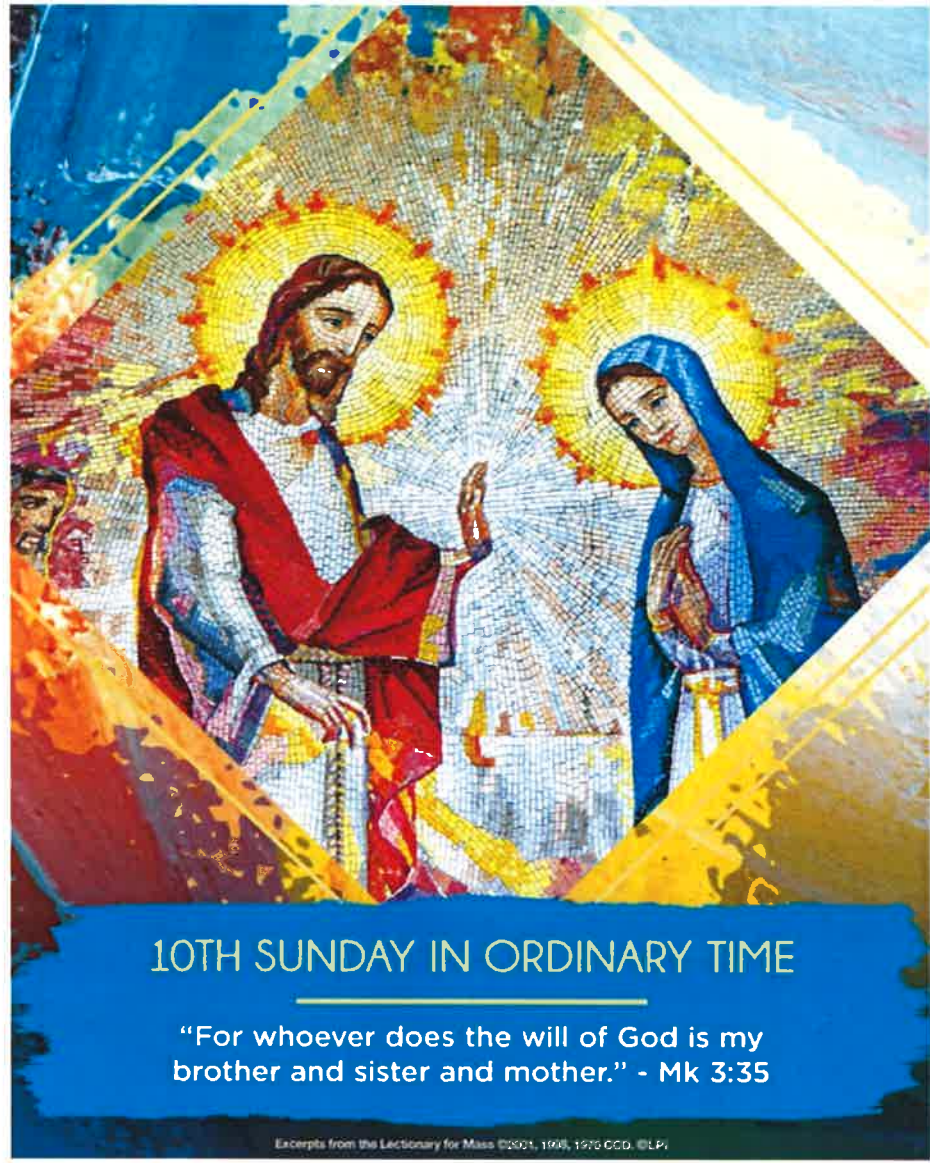

Dear Parishioners,

In Genesis 3:9-15, we witness a pivotal moment in the history of mankind. After Adam and Eve had eaten from the forbidden tree, they realized their nakedness and hid from God's presence. God, in His infinite mercy, sought them out and called to them, “Where are you?” This simple question reveals God's desire for us to acknowledge our mistakes and face the consequences of our actions. As Adam and Eve respond to God's call, they acknowledge their fear and shame. God then engages in a dialogue with them, questioning their actions and holding them accountable. This exchange highlights the importance of taking responsibility for our choices and recognizing the consequences that follow.

One of the significant consequences mentioned in this passage is the curse placed upon the serpent. God declares that the serpent will be cursed above all livestock, and enmity will be put between the serpent and the woman, and between their offspring. This foreshadows the ongoing struggle between good and evil throughout history, with the promise of ultimate victory through the seed of the woman, referring to Jesus Christ. In this passage, we also witness the first glimmer of hope amidst the consequences. God promises that the offspring of the woman will crush the head of the serpent while the serpent will strike his heel. This prophecy points towards the future redemption and salvation brought by Jesus Christ, who would ultimately triumph over sin and death.

As we reflect on Genesis 3:9-15, we are reminded of our own tendency to hide from God when we make mistakes. However, God's pursuit of Adam and Eve reveals His unending love and desire for reconciliation. It also serves as a reminder that our choices have consequences, but there is always hope and redemption available through Jesus Christ. May we strive to acknowledge our mistakes, take responsibility for our actions, and find comfort in the promise of God's ultimate victory over evil.
