





Dear Parishioners,

I would kindly ask of your prayers this week for my family and myself. As some of you may have heard, my dad passed away this past Tuesday at the VA hospital in Syracuse. He has had a long road since a stroke he sustained in 2016. Over the last couple of days since he has been in the hospital, I am reminded of the reading from St. Paul which says "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith". Over these last seven years it has taught me to cherish the moments with loved ones as we do not know the time nor the hour. As a priest, I preach this all the time at funerals, but when it comes to applying it to yourself, it always hits differently. But as St. Paul says, we keep the faith. A faith that says we will all meet again and be together.

Faith as we all know is something that we work at and is often stronger some times over others. When we stumble and fall, we know that our faith helps us get back up and continue the journey. No matter how difficult the journey, our faith makes us ready for anything. This is easy to say, but an entirely different aspect to apply to our lives. Along the way we may get angry or frustrated with God and ask "why, how much longer?", but we recognize that at the end we will emerge stronger and with a deeper faith.

As St. Paul talks about in his second letter to Timothy, we have fought the fight, finished the race, and kept the faith. One on hand our lives can be looked at as a race. Not in the sense that we rush them, but as we pace ourselves and journey through the ups and downs of life. When we get to the point where we are tired or we feel as though we don't know where to go, we look to our faith to get us through. May our faith be our guide this week as we journey through the races of life.
