


2023 HOPE APPEAL Impact Report

How Your Gift to 2023 HOPE Appeal Was Used:

The 2023 HOPE Appeal raised \$4,766,718 to provide support for immediate needs across the Diocese of Syracuse. \$3,830,803 supported ministries and programs, \$730,859 was given to parishes through Parish Sharing and campaign expenses totaled \$205,856.
