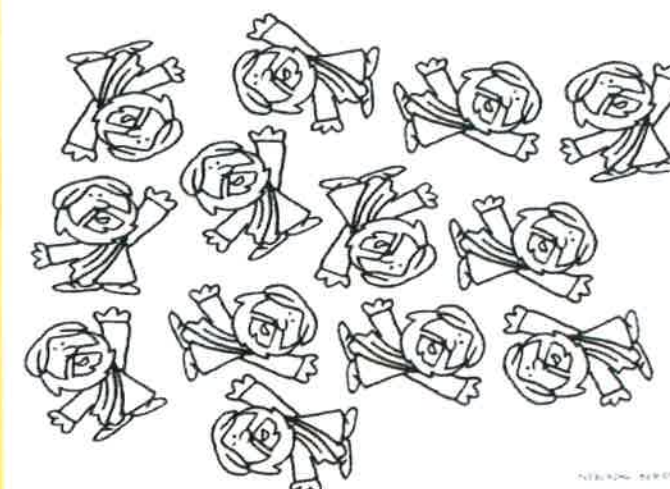


The Sanctuary Candle for the month of July is offered for Willard & Mary Thayer by their nine children and their families.
