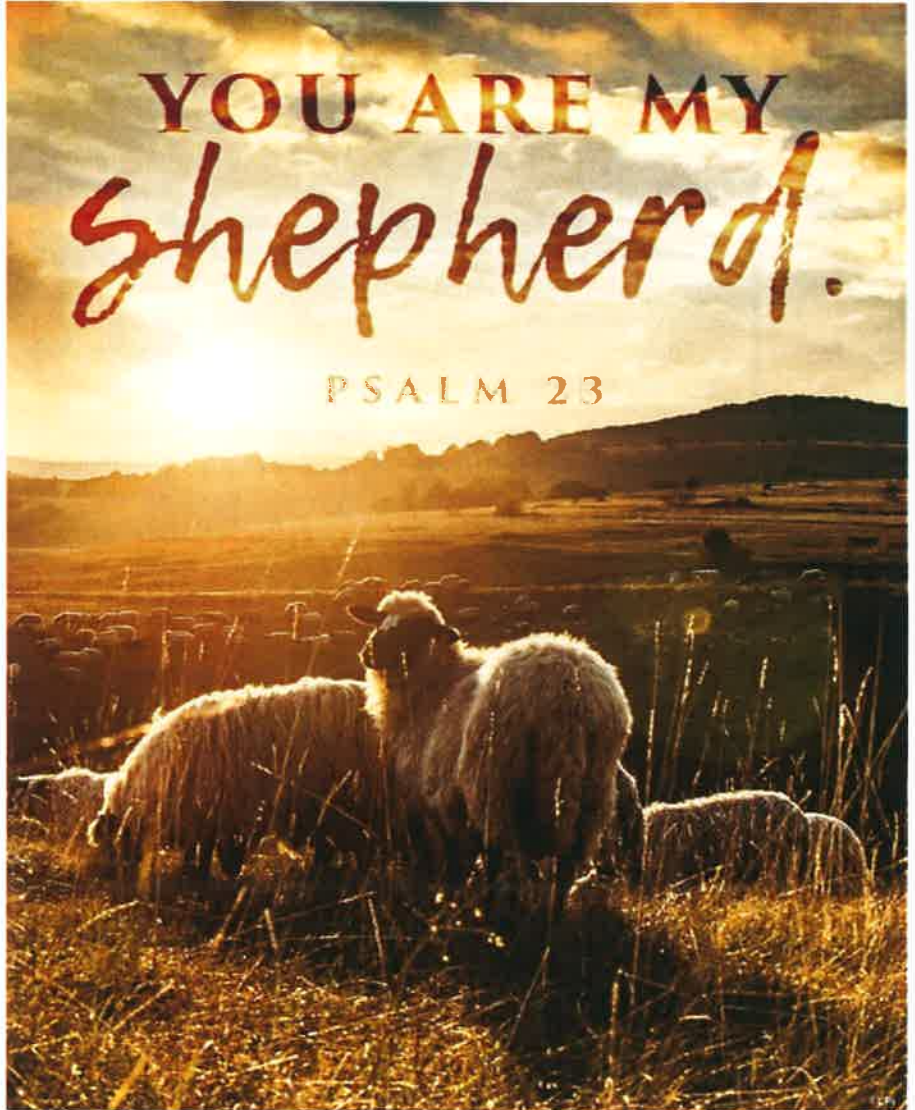

Dear Parishioners,

Our first Reading is taken from Jeremiah 23:1-6. This is a powerful passage that speaks to the responsibility of leaders and the faithfulness of God. In these verses, the prophet Jeremiah condemns the shepherds of Israel for their failure to care for and protect the people entrusted to their care. He describes them as "shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture" (Jeremiah 23:1). This indictment serves as a reminder that leaders have a sacred duty to guide and nurture those under their authority.



Jeremiah then contrasts these corrupt leaders with the promise of a righteous and just ruler who will come. God declares, "I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land" (Jeremiah 23:5). This future ruler, often understood as a messianic figure, is characterized by his righteousness, wisdom, and commitment to justice. He will bring about a transformation in the leadership of Israel, restoring faith and trust in the governance of the nation.

As I reflect on this passage, I am reminded of the importance of leadership in all aspects of life. Whether in politics, business, or even within our own families, leaders have a profound impact on the well-being and success of those under their care. It is a sobering reminder that leaders must prioritize the needs of others above their own ambitions and desires.

Furthermore, Jeremiah 23:1-6 also highlights the faithfulness of God. Despite the failures of human leaders, God promises to raise up a righteous leader who will bring about justice and righteousness. This assurance gives us hope and reminds us that God is always working to bring about redemption and restoration in the world.

Our first reading, challenges us to reflect on the responsibilities of leaders and the faithfulness of God. It serves as a call to leaders to prioritize the well-being of those under their care and a reminder that God is ultimately in control, working to bring about justice and righteousness in the world.
