

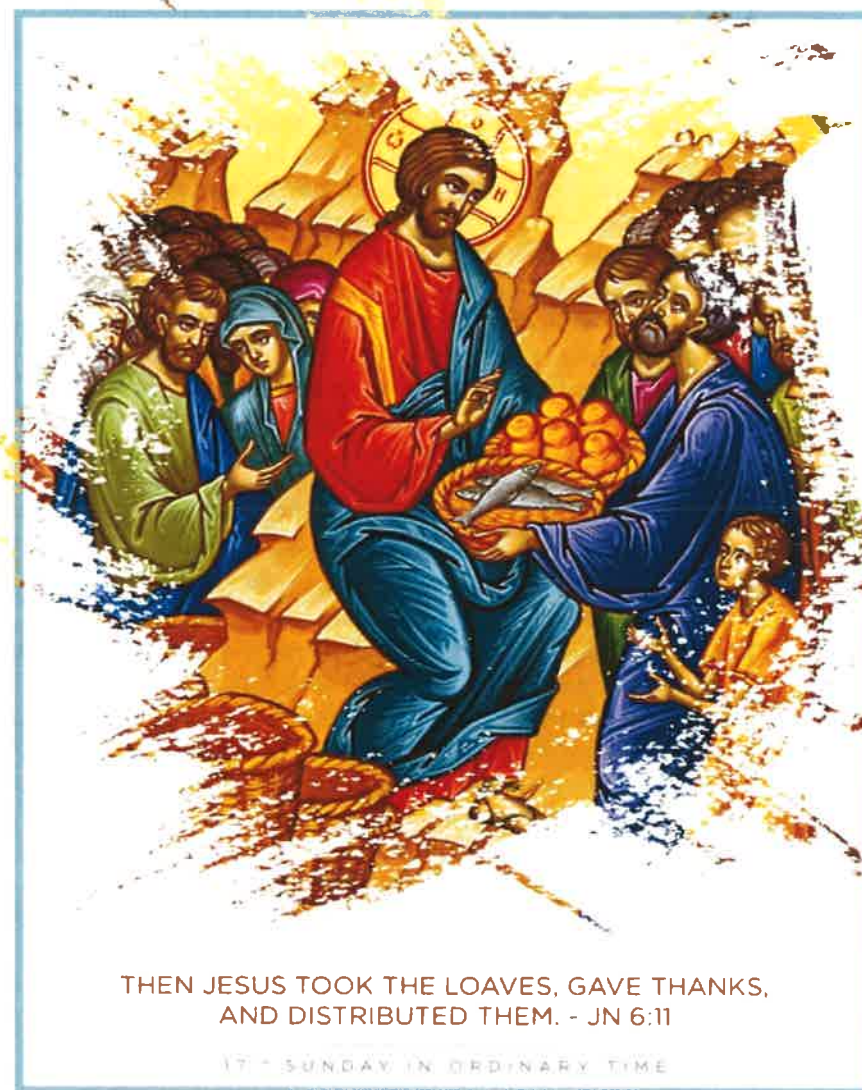

Dear Parishioners,



In John 6:1-15, we encounter the famous story of Jesus feeding the multitude with five loaves of bread and two fish. This event is often referred to as the "Feeding of the 5,000" and is followed by Jesus' discourse on the bread of life. This passage holds significant theological and spiritual implications that resonate with believers today. The story begins with Jesus' compassion towards the crowd, as He recognizes their physical hunger. He takes the limited resources available and multiplies them, providing an abundance of food for all. This miracle reveals Jesus' divine power and His willingness to meet the needs of His followers.

However, Jesus uses this opportunity to teach a deeper spiritual truth. He tells the people, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty" (John 6:35). Jesus uses the metaphor of bread to convey the idea that He is the ultimate source of nourishment and satisfaction for our spiritual hunger. As we reflect on this passage, we are reminded that Jesus is not only concerned with our physical needs but also our spiritual well-being. Just as bread sustains and satisfies our physical hunger, Jesus offers Himself as the sustenance for our souls. He invites us to come to Him, to believe in Him, and to find true fulfillment in His presence.

The bread of life discourse challenges us to examine our priorities and desires. Are we seeking after temporary pleasures and material possessions, or are we pursuing a deep and intimate relationship with Jesus? Are we feeding on the bread that perishes or on the bread that endures to eternal life? The bread of life discourse invites us to seek Jesus as the ultimate source of nourishment for our souls. It reminds us of His compassion, power, and the invitation to believe in Him and find eternal satisfaction. May we continually feast on the bread of life and share it with others, that they too may experience the fullness of Christ.

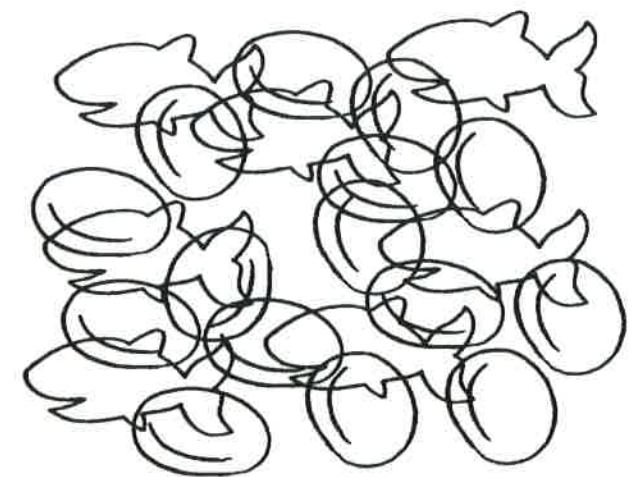


The Sanctuary Candle for the month of July is offered for Willard & Mary Thayer by their nine children and their families.
