Dear Parishioners,



It has been brought to my attention, that a number of parishioners have received an email from someone saying they are me. The emails say something to the effect that I need help, or I'm in need of money or gift cards. This is a scam that has been going around for a while with many priests throughout the diocese and is most definitely not me. Please do not reply to the email or provide any information and just delete it.

The Feast of Epiphany, marks the revelation of Christ to the Gentiles. This feast primarily commemorates the visit of the Magi, or Wise Men, who traveled from distant lands, guided by a star, to pay homage to the newborn Jesus. This event serves as a powerful reminder of the universality of Christ's message, transcending cultural and geographic boundaries. Reflecting on the Feast of Epiphany invites us to consider the themes of revelation and recognition. The Magi, despite their status as outsiders, demonstrate a deep understanding and reverence for the divine. Their journey symbolizes the quest for truth and the willingness to seek out the light in a world often shrouded in darkness. This pursuit of knowledge and understanding resonates with our own lives, encouraging us to remain open to new insights and perspectives.

Moreover, Epiphany challenges us to reflect on our own responses to the revelation of Christ. Are we, like the Magi, willing to embark on our own journeys to seek and recognize the divine in our lives? The gifts they presented—gold, frankincense, and myrrh—represent not only material offerings but also signify the acknowledgment of Jesus' kingship, divinity, and humanity. The Feast of Epiphany is not merely a historical event but a call to action. It invites us to reflect on our own paths of discovery, to recognize the light of Christ in our midst, and to share that light with others. As we celebrate this feast, may we be inspired to seek truth, offer our gifts, and embrace the guidance that leads us to deeper faith and understanding.
