Dear Parishioners,

There are a number of things that I would like to address in this week's column. First and foremost, I would like to announce that we have surpassed our Hope Appeal goal of \$18,178. To date we have raised just short of \$25,000 dollars which means the entire overage will come back to us. Thank you to everyone who has given to this campaign and helped us reach our goal.

We will be having a covered dish supper on March 2nd from 5PM to 7PM at Gill Hall in Boonville. This will be a dish to pass event, and the theme will be Mardi Gras. Sign-up sheets are available at the front entrance of the Church. This will be a great time to get together as a parish family and enjoy some fellowship and good food. During the season of Lent this year, we will be having an opportunity to deepen our faith. If you attended last year's program during Lenton Catholicism, this year will be similar with doing a series, gather for a meal, and converse about what we learn. Stay tuned for more information on this in the coming weeks.

If you remember about two years ago Bishop Lucia held a listening session at St Joseph Church in Boonville in response to the Synod promulgated by the Holy Father. During Lent, we will be continuing a process as a diocese to further aid in pastoral planning throughout the diocese. The Syracuse Diocese has been awarded a grant to have a company called the "Catholic Leadership Institute" to provide a study throughout the diocese to aid in pastoral planning, and the strengths and weaknesses of each parish. An anonymous online survey will be available during the season of Lent for each family to fill out. This will help us identify our strengths and weaknesses of the parish.

Lastly, I am very excited to announce a new parish program called "Formed". This is an online portal through Augustine Institute that every parishioner will have access to and we will be using for various events, such as bible studies, movie nights, and other programs that will be starting in the spring/summer. There will be a location in the bulletin called "this week on Formed" each week highlighting various programs that can be used for kids, teens, families, and adult catechesis. Be on the lookout and have a Blessed Week!
