Just as a reminder this Sunday March 2nd is our Mardi Gras Dinner at Gill Hall in Boonville from 5PM – 7PM. It is going to be a great time to gather and have some good food. Please bring a dish to pass and join us for some good food, and conversation.



This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, there will be two opportunities for Mass and to receive Ashes. Morning Mass will be at St Patrick's in Forestport at 8:30 AM and the evening mass will be at St Josephs at 6PM. As we gather for Mass, we hear the words "remember you are dust and to dust you shall return". A sobering reminder of life and death. 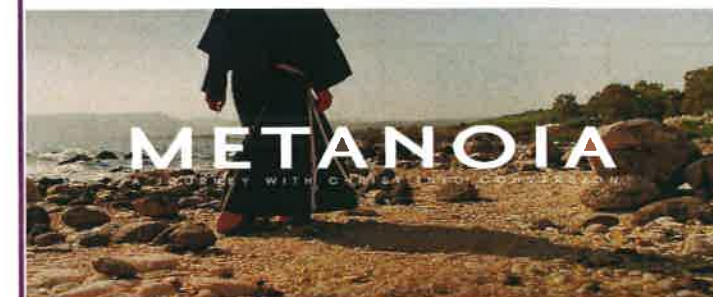
