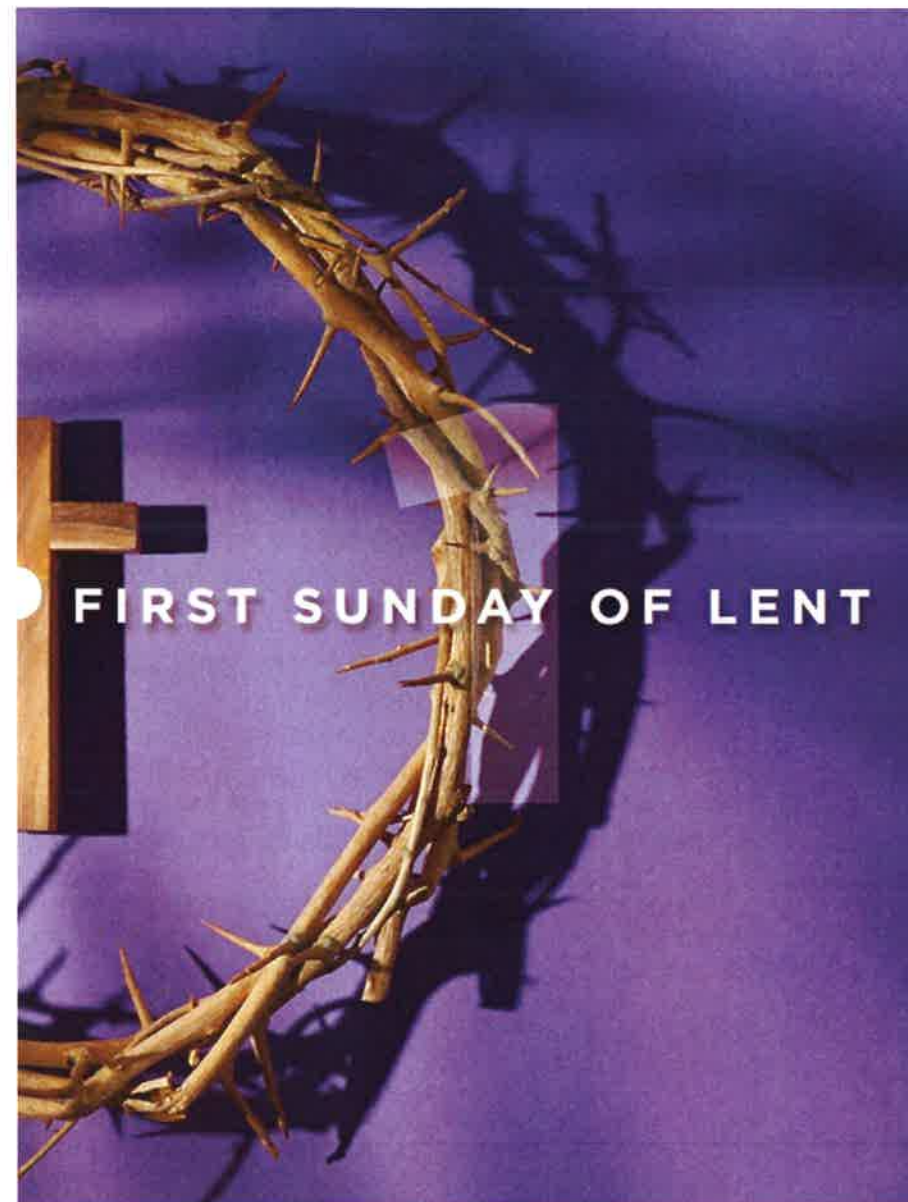

As we begin this first Sunday of Lent, we are reminded in the readings that temptation is a reality. 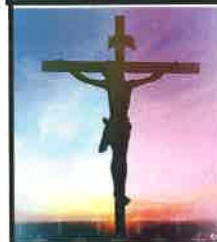
