

Dear Parishioners,

The passage from John 8:1-11 recounts a powerful moment in the ministry of Jesus. As Jesus was teaching in the temple



courts, the scribes and Pharisees brought to him a woman caught in the act of adultery. They presented her to Jesus, testing him, and asking what should be done according to the law of Moses, which called for such a woman to be stoned. The scribes and Pharisees were hoping to trap Jesus, thinking that no matter how he responded, they could accuse him. If he said she should not be stoned, they could charge him with opposing the Mosaic law. But if he agreed she should be stoned, they could turn him in to the Roman authorities, who did not permit the Jews to carry out such executions.

Yet Jesus did not fall into their trap. Instead, he responded with a profound wisdom and mercy. He bent down and began writing on the ground with his finger. When they persisted in questioning him, he straightened up and said, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." One by one, the accusers dropped their stones and walked away. Finally, Jesus was left alone with the woman. He asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" When she replied that no one had, Jesus said, "Then neither do I condemn you. Go now and leave your life of sin."

This remarkable encounter reveals the heart of Jesus - a heart of compassion and grace, unwilling to condemn the sinner, but calling her to turn from her sin. It is a beautiful picture of the gospel, where Jesus does not excuse our sin, but offers forgiveness and the power to walk in newness of life. This story reminds us that Jesus is able to look past our failures and shame and extend to us the gift of his mercy and transforming grace.
