

Dear Parishioners,

I want to take this opportunity to wish everyone a happy Easter. As we have journeyed through this Holy week, we



have recounted the triumphant entrance into Jerusalem of Jesus on Palm Sunday, the institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday, the Passion and Death of Christ on Friday, a time of Holy waiting on Saturday, and finally we arrive at the Resurrection on this Easter Sunday. As we often say in the Church, we are an Easter people. We believe in the Resurrection and the power of the Cross. Although used as an instrument of torture, it is the ultimate image of Love. The Love that Christ freely gives by giving of His life for us.
