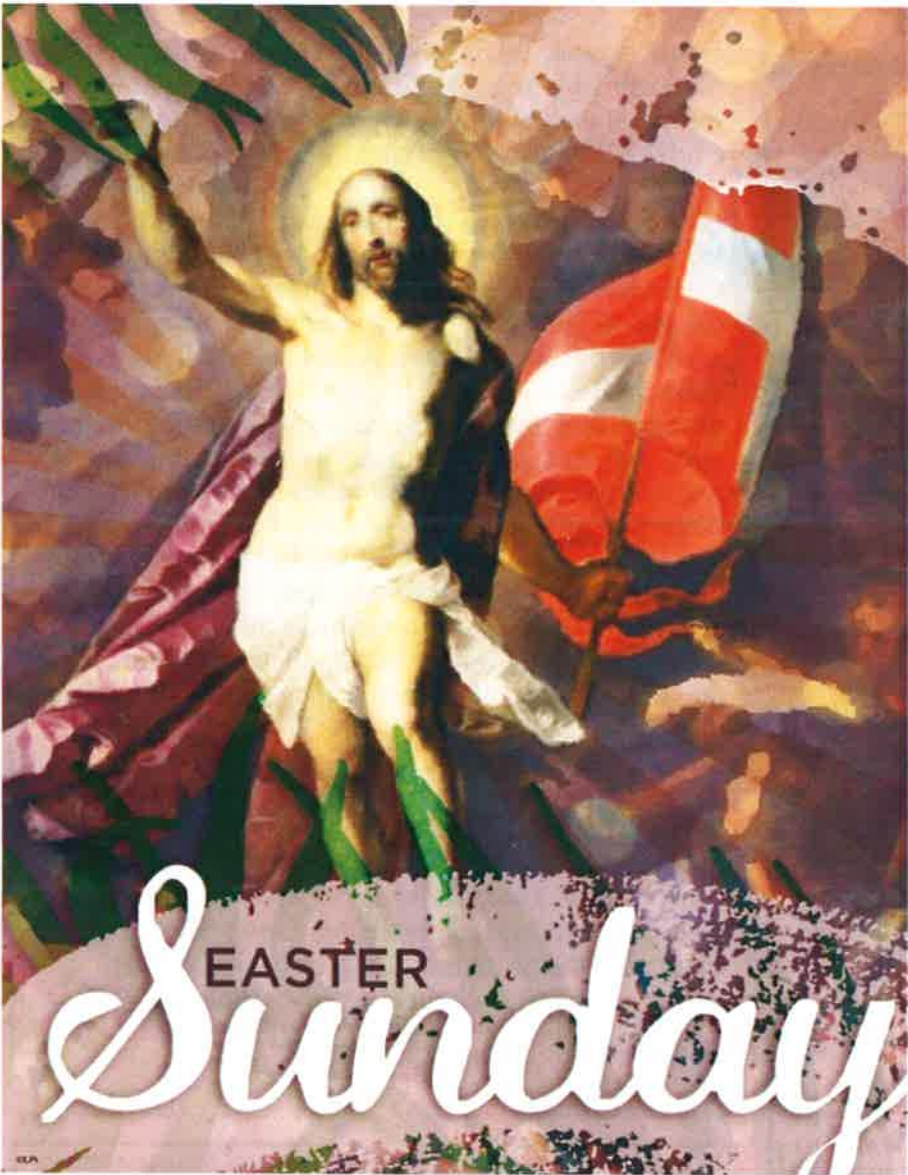

Dear Parishioners,



I want to take this opportunity to wish everyone a happy Easter. As we have journeyed through this Holy week, we have recounted the triumphant entrance into Jerusalem of Jesus on Palm Sunday, the institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday, the Passion and Death of Christ on Friday, a time of Holy waiting on Saturday, and finally we arrive at the Resurrection on this Easter Sunday. As we often say in the Church, we are an Easter people. We believe in the Resurrection and the power of the Cross. Although used as an instrument of torture, it is the ultimate image of Love. The Love that Christ freely gives by giving of His life for us.

As we shift from the shouts of crucify him, to Alleluia He is Risen, we should be reminded that the Love Christ has for us is beyond all understanding. In our Gospel on Holy Saturday, see a love that was reaffirmed today by Peter. As someone who denied knowing Jesus not once but three times, first runs to the tomb and immediately enters without hesitation. Although they are still unclear as to what it meant “to rise from the dead” you can imagine their amazement when they find that Jesus was not their and has risen from the dead. Over the next weeks leading up to Pentecost, we will hear of the many appearance stories and accounts of those who witness this. May we as a Church have this conviction that Peter has, and also the disciples once they realize their roll in all of this.

For each of us, we have a part in God’s plan for salvation, at times, we may ask what His plan is, or how am I a part of this plan, but we must learn to trust in God and have the courage as peter did and the conviction as Thomas did as he says My Lord and My God. May we who celebrate this Easter Sunday be filled with the grace that flows from God as we celebrate as a Church this Easter season.
