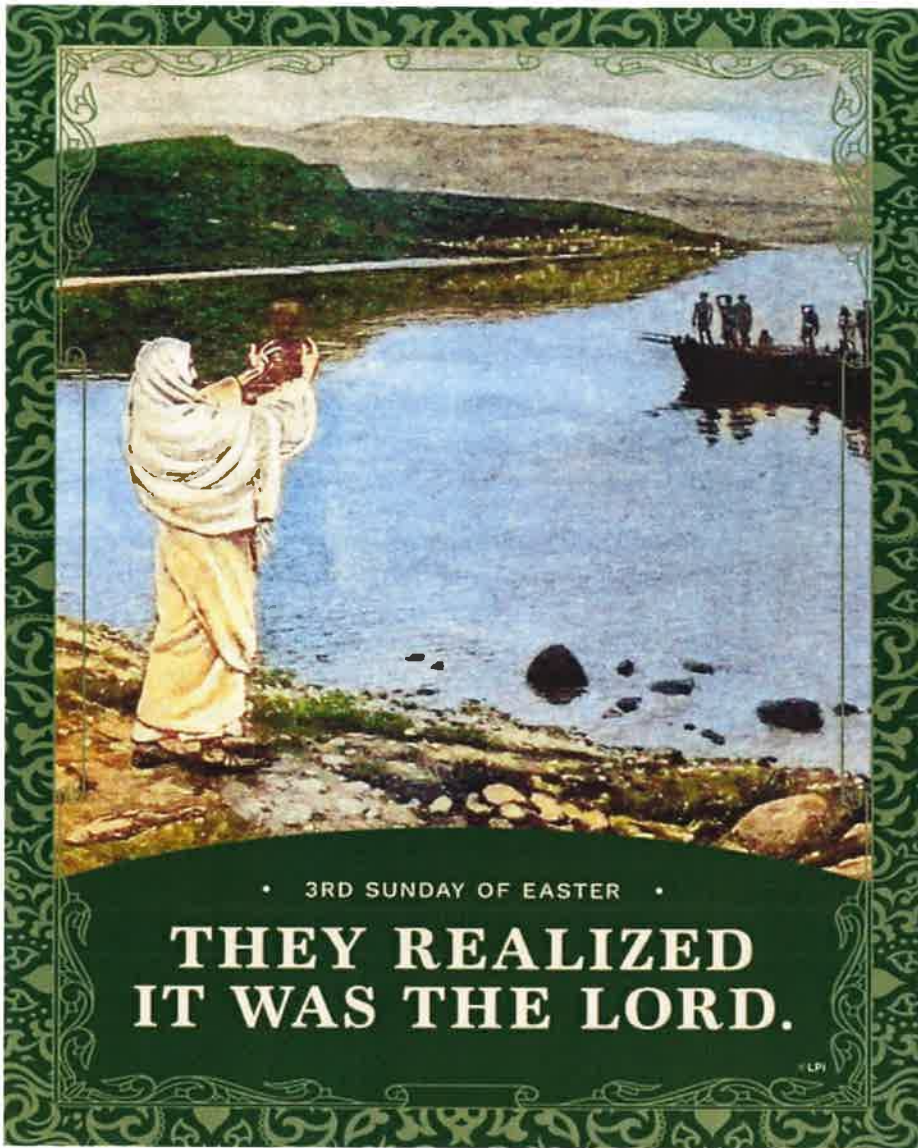

Dear Parishioners,



This weekend, we celebrate a very special time for our young people. At 9:30AM Mass this weekend, we will be celebrating First Communion. This is always a joy-filled times as we recall the first time we received Christ in the Eucharist. Please keep our First Communicants in your prayers as they celebrate their First Communion this weekend.

In our gospel this weekend, John 21:1-19 is a poignant passage that captures the essence of redemption and restoration. The narrative unfolds after Jesus' resurrection, where He appears to His disciples by the Sea of Tiberias. Initially, the disciples return to their old lives, going fishing, which symbolizes a retreat to familiarity in the face of uncertainty. Their night of fishing yields nothing, echoing their feelings of failure and confusion.

At dawn, Jesus appears on the shore, instructing them to cast their nets on the right side of the boat. This simple act leads to an overwhelming catch, illustrating that with Jesus, what seems fruitless can become fruitful. The recognition of Jesus by John signifies the importance of recognizing His presence in our lives.

The dialogue between Jesus and Peter is particularly striking. Jesus asks Peter three times if he loves Him, paralleling Peter's three denials. This repetition serves as a powerful reminder of grace and the opportunity for redemption. Jesus not only forgives Peter but also reinstates him, emphasizing the call to shepherd His flock. This passage teaches us about the transformative power of love and the importance of following Christ's guidance in our lives, highlighting that no matter our past, we are given a chance to start anew.
