Dear Parishioners,



John 17:20-26 presents a profound and intimate glimpse into Jesus' prayer for His followers, emphasizing themes of unity, love, and the divine relationship between the Father, the Son, and believers. This passage occurs in the context of Jesus' final moments with His disciples before His crucifixion, making it particularly poignant.

In these verses, Jesus prays not only for His immediate disciples but also for those who will come to believe in Him through their message. This inclusivity highlights the expansive nature of Christ's mission, extending beyond His earthly ministry to encompass all future generations of believers. The desire for unity is central to His prayer: "that they may be one as we are one." This call for unity challenges the divisions that often characterize human relationships, urging believers to reflect the oneness found in the Trinity. It emphasizes that unity is not merely a goal but a testament to the authenticity of Christ's Mission.

Moreover, the passage underscores the importance of love. Jesus speaks of the love that the Father has for Him, which He now shares with His followers. This love is transformative, enabling believers to reflect God's character in the world. It calls for a communal response among Christians, fostering an environment where love prevails over discord.

Jesus also reveals His ultimate desire for believers: that they may experience the fullness of His glory and the joy that stems from being in relationship with Him. This invitation to experience divine glory emphasizes the depth and richness of the Christian faith, suggesting that it is not merely about following rules but about entering into a vibrant, life-giving relationship with God.

John 17:20-26 serves as a powerful reminder of the interconnectedness of believers, the call to unity in love, and the profound relationship believers are invited to share with the Trinity. It challenges us to embody these principles in our lives, reflecting the heart of Christ's prayer in our interactions and communities.

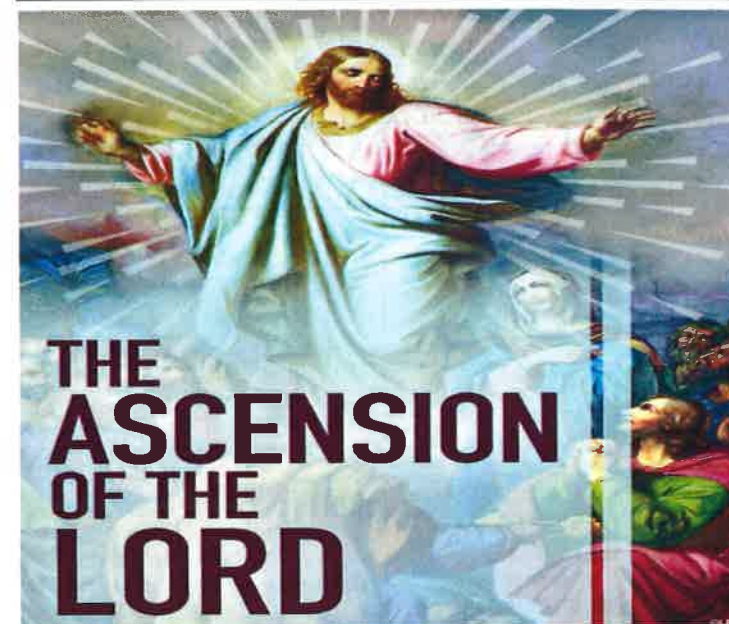

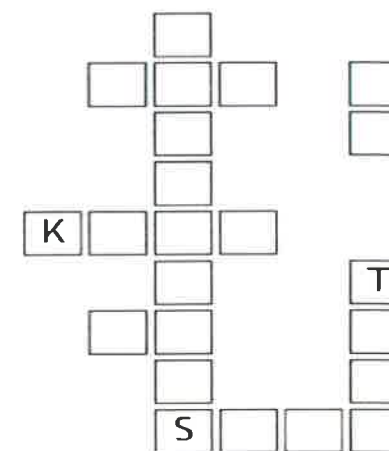
