

Dear Parishioners.

John 20:19-23 presents a poignant and transformative moment in the narrative of Jesus' resurrection.

This passage occurs on the even-



ing of the resurrection day when the disciples are gathered in fear, hiding behind locked doors. Their world has been turned upside down, and they are grappling with the reality of Jesus' crucifixion and the uncertainty of what lies ahead. In this context, the arrival of Jesus brings a profound sense of peace and purpose.

When Jesus stands among them and declares, "Peace be with you," He does more than offer a greeting; He reassures them of His presence and His enduring love. This peace is not merely the absence of fear but a deep, abiding tranquility that comes from knowing that the risen Christ is with them. It highlights the transformative power of Jesus' resurrection, which dispels fear and instills hope. Following this, Jesus shows them His hands and side, affirming His identity and the reality of His sacrifice. This act serves to remind the disciples of the depth of His love and the cost of their salvation. It is a powerful invitation to move beyond fear and doubt, encouraging them to embrace their role as witnesses to the resurrection.

The passage culminates with Jesus breathing on the disciples and saying, "Receive the Holy Spirit." This moment marks the commissioning of the disciples, empowering them to continue the work of Christ. The Holy Spirit is given not just as a comforter but as a source of strength and guidance for their mission. The authority to forgive sins symbolizes the radical nature of the Gospel—the message of grace and reconciliation that they are called to share with the world. John 20:19-23, we see themes of fear transformed into courage, isolation into community, and despair into hope. This passage serves as a reminder that the risen Christ meets us in our fears, offers us peace, and empowers us through the Holy Spirit to be agents of His love and forgiveness in a world that longs for redemption.
