Dear friends in Christ,
In the first reading this weekend Moses explains to the people that...*this command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious and remote for you.... No, it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts...*
The law of the Lord is written on the heart of each individual person and in heeding the voice of a well formed conscience each of us discovers our unique dignity and freedom. Pope John Paul II explains:

The relationship between man's freedom and God's law is most deeply lived out in the "heart" of the person, in his moral conscience. As the Second Vatican Council observed: "In the depths of his conscience man detects a law which he does not impose on himself, but which holds him to obedience. Always summoning him to love good and avoid evil, the voice of conscience can when necessary speak to his heart more specifically: 'do this, shun that'. For man has in his heart a law written by God. To obey it is the very dignity of man; according to it he will be judged Veritatis Splendor, #54)

Because a well formed conscience convicts us of our sins and affirms right action, when listened to, it becomes the source of an authentic dignity and freedom. Still, all of us fail to be faithful to the law we find written on the heart. Here, we should be moved to gratitude to Jesus Our Savior who through the mercy of His passion frees us from our slavery to sin and truly sets us free to become children of God.

Finally, please keep myself, students and chaperones in your prayers as we make our way to the youth conference in Ohio this weekend. Also, continue to pray for the Totus Tuus program that begins on Monday.
