



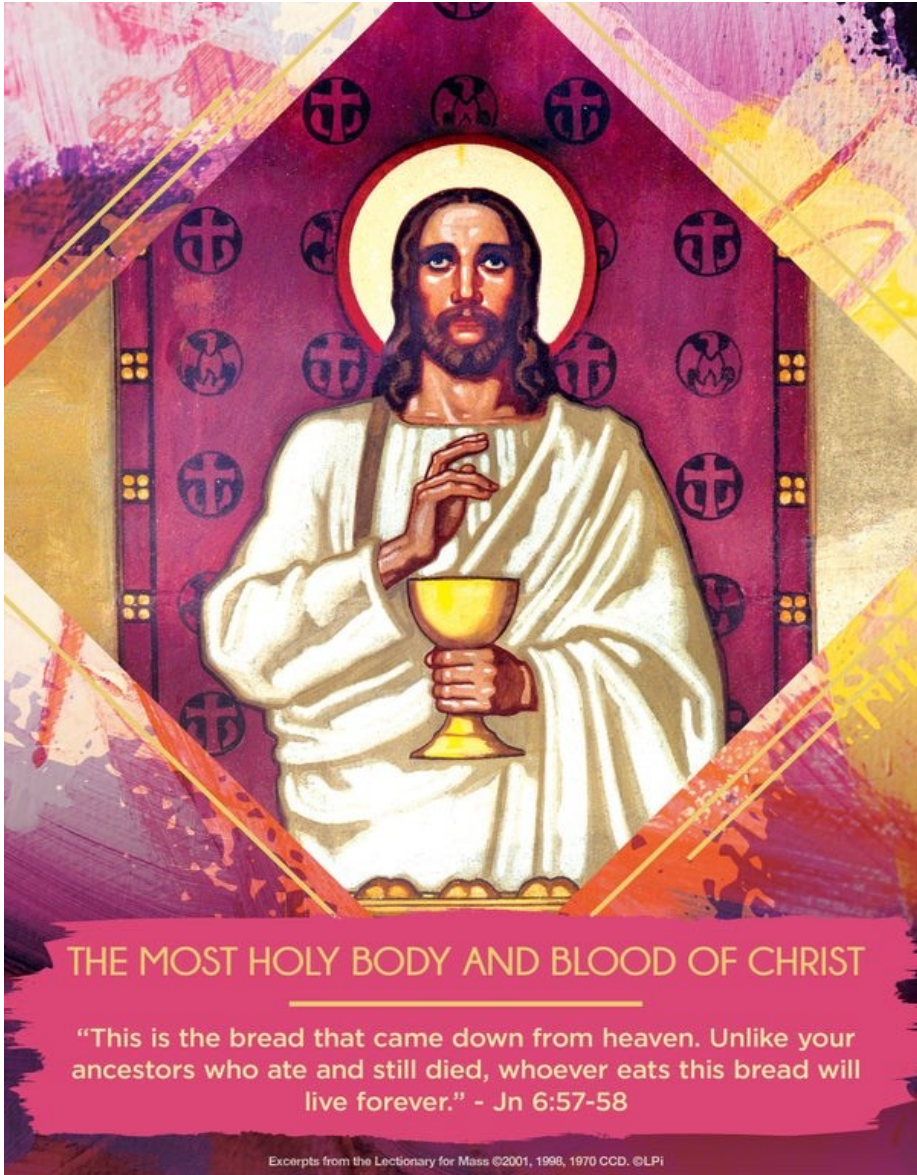

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Before we celebrate the Sundays of Ordinary Time for the remainder of the Liturgical Year, we have one great feast that invites us to contemplate the central mystery of our Catholic faith. This weekend, we celebrate The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ: Corpus Christi. The use of a Sequence, after the Second Reading, signifies the importance of this solemnity. From the the Sequence we hear the following:

Full and clear ring out your chanting, Joy nor sweetest grace be wanting, From your heart let praises burst: For today the feast is holden, When the institution olden Of that supper was rehearsed.

The rehearsed institution olden is a reference to the Passover meal that the Jewish people would celebrate to commemorate the freedom they had gained when their ancestors fled Egypt after eating the first Passover meal. (see Exodus 11) During that meal, a lamb was sacrificed so that the first born son of the family would be redeemed by its blood when the angel of death passed over Egypt. It was during The Last Supper that Jesus transformed the Old Testament Passover into the redemptive sacrifice of the New Covenant. Rather than sacrificing a lamb, Jesus would turn bread and wine into His own Body and Blood that would eventually be sacrificed on the Cross to bring about our redemption. The eternally begotten Son of God became, for us, the Lamb who takes away the sins of the world!

The Sequence continues: What He did at supper seated, Christ ordained to be repeated, His memorial ne'er to cease: And His rule for guidance taking, Bread and wine we hallow, making Thus our sacrifice of peace. This the truth each Christian learns, Bread into His flesh he turns, To His precious blood the wine: Sight has fail'd, nor thought conceives, But a dauntless faith believes, Resting on a pow'r divine.

Pope John Paul II, in his encyclical The Church and the Eucharist explains: The Church was born of the paschal mystery. For this very reason the Eucharist, which is in an outstanding way the sacrament of the paschal mystery, stands at the center of the Church's life. This is already clear from the earliest images of the Church found in the Acts of the Apostles: "They devoted themselves to the Apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (2:42). The "breaking of the bread" refers to the Eucharist. Two thousand years later, we continue to relive that primordial image of the Church. At every celebration of the Eucharist, we are spiritually brought back to the paschal Triduum: to the events of the evening of Holy Thursday, to the Last Supper and to what followed it. (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA, #3)

The Divine Liturgy not only makes present the Sacrifice of the Cross, it is also a participation in the heavenly liturgy. From the Book of Revelation we read: I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no man could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits upon the throne, and to the Lamb!" (Revelation 7:9,10)

It is my hope and prayer that all of us will continue to grow in our love and reverence for the Lord who makes Himself present to us in the appearance of bread and wine. Grace be with you all,


